During this period, he was involved in the financial restructuring of the group and in the strategic refocus of its business on food retail and in Poland, and maintained responsibility for Investor Relations.

In 2015, he was appointed Chairman of the Board of Directors of PHAROL, initially accumulating this position with that of Chief Executive Officer and, from 2017, with that of Managing Director.
